Notes on the activity calendars

- The current version of the calendar is an August 2007 release. At this stage, the calendar is currently about 80% confirmed. There will be a new release of the calendar in April of 2008 and another one in late June of 2008 with final and confirmed activities. No calendar is ever 100% guaranteed due to weather or other events beyond our control, so changes, although unlikely, are possible even hours before an activity.
- The most common reasons for us making changes are group bookings and different student number distributions. Our priority is to make sure all students (or as many as possible) get to participate in all major activities, especially Niagara Falls and Wonderland in Toronto and 1000 Islands and Toronto Day Trip for Kingston students. To do this we examine our registrations closely before the start of the camp and make adjustments to accommodate all students accordingly.
- Only students registered for a full 4-week program are guaranteed to take part in all major activities. Students registered for lesser periods may not be able to take part in all major activities. For example: a student registered for a two week program, arriving on Saturday and departing on Saturday will not be able to take part in the Wonderland Trip and a Niagara Falls trip within that time period.
- Additional or different activities WILL NOT be arranged for individual students and for groups of less than 35 students. Students are not allowed under any circumstance to take part in activities not organized by IH Toronto, with or without parental permission.
- Student MUST take part in all activities arranged, and may not leave campus unsupervised for taking part in other activities.
- All activities are supervised by IH Toronto Staff. On all activities, students are divided into small groups and assigned an activity coordinator who will be responsible for their wellbeing and attendance during the activity.

Ottawa, Montreal Quebec Trip (\$459 Cnd.)

Students taking part in York University's Glendon Campus in Toronto have the option of adding a 2 night, 3 day trip to French Canada from July 18th to 20th, 2008. This trip will take the students through Ottawa, Montreal and Quebec City and return students to the college Sunday night. Students taking part in this trip will miss one day of class on Friday and the planned activities for that weekend, none of which can be made up. Students will be housed in very nice accommodations on quad basis per room with en-suite and have all their meals and activities paid for the entire duration of the trip.

Toronto, Niagara Falls Trip (\$499 Cnd.)

Students taking part in the Queen's University Campus in Kingston City have the option of adding a 2 night, 3 day trip to Toronto and Niagara Falls to their trip from July 25th to July 27th, 2008. This trip will take the students to Toronto for a 2-night stay with a day trip to Niagara Falls and the beautiful city of Niagara On The Lake. Students taking part in this trip will miss one day of class on Friday and the planned activities for that weekend, none of which can be made up. Students will be housed in very nice accommodations on quad basis per room with en-suite and have all their meals and activities paid for the entire duration of the trip.
